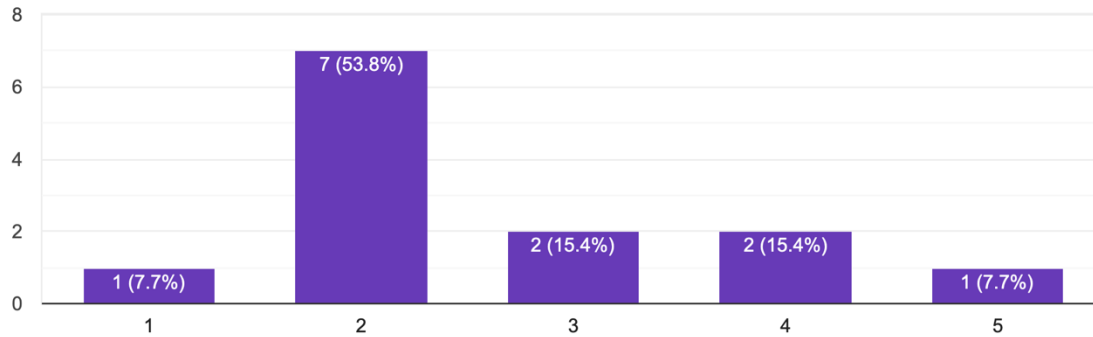


Plagiarism and AI Opinions Quiz: Class Results

Very much disagree (1) to very much agree (5)

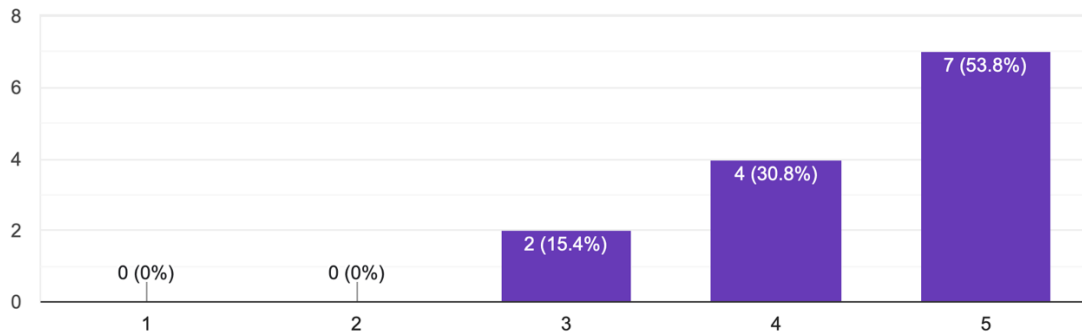
How much do you agree with this statement? Everyone plagiarizes to some degree or another.

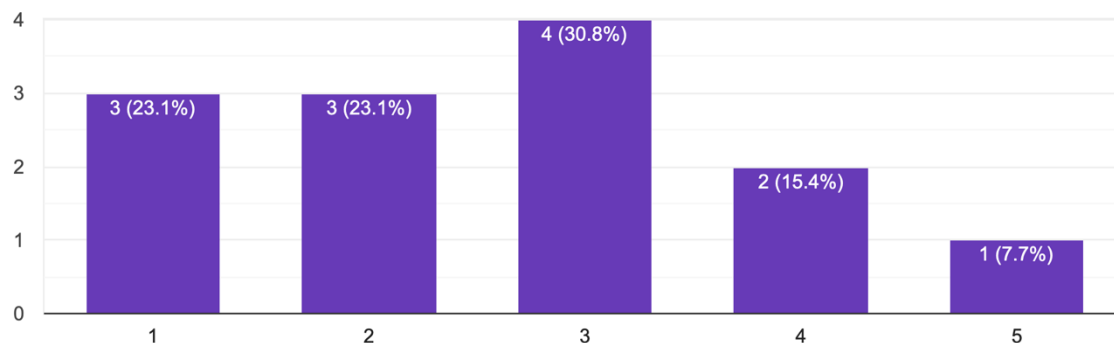
Plagiarism is a serious violation of someone's rights.

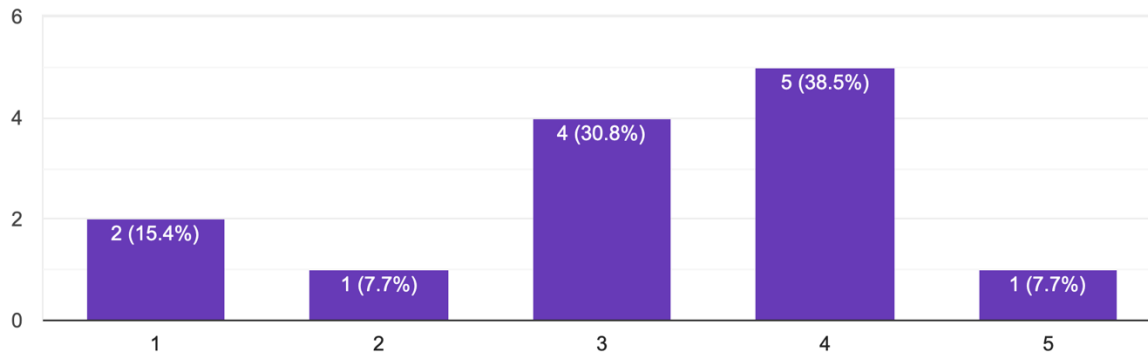

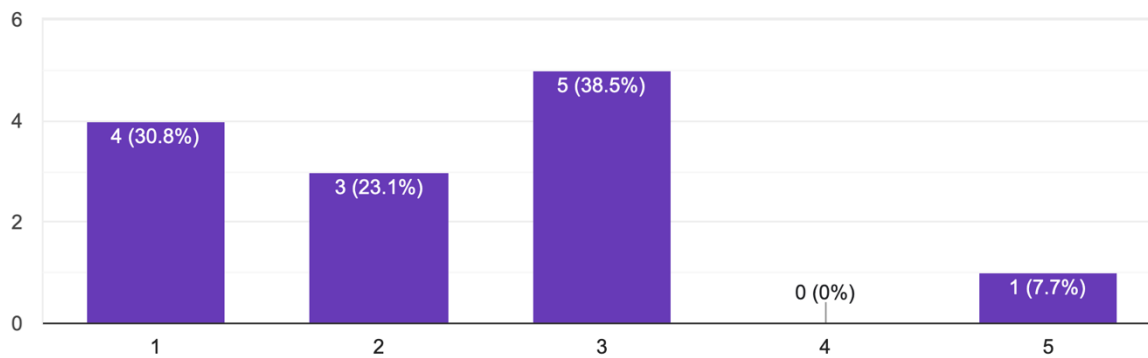
AI will lead to academics who don't know how to write well on their own.

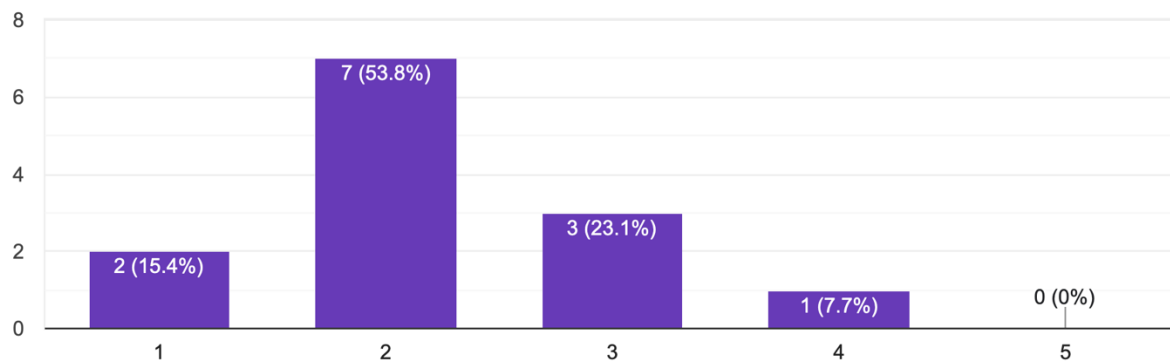

In your opinion, how will AI impact the novelty / creativity of research?

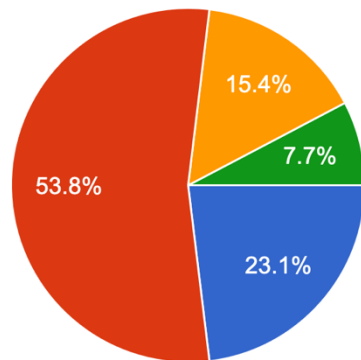

Should plagiarism detected in a doctoral dissertation result in revocation of the degree?

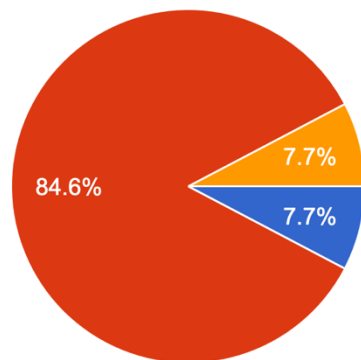

Do you think the focus on plagiarism is overblown?

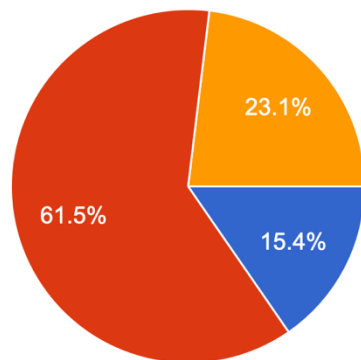
